### **Changes to the Car Park**

Please follow the instructions below for free parking on Sunday in the Scots' Church car park.

# 1. Entering The Car park

Take a car park ticket on entry to the car park by pressing the button in the red rectangle.

# 2. Obtaining your follow-on ticket

- a. Before you leave, go to the welcome desk at the main entry to the Church, show the ticket you received at the boom gate to Michael, or another person attending the desk.
- b. Michael will give you a follow-on ticket to use for payment on the way out.
- c. You must keep the car park ticket and follow on ticket to exit the car park.

## 3. Exiting the Car Park at the boom gate

- a. First, scan the barcode on your original car park ticket using the scanner on the left hand side and the price will be displayed on the screen.
- b. When the price is displayed scan the bar code on the follow-on ticket
- c. Exit the car park as normal. If you have problems, use the call button on the unit to speak to an operator.
