UPDATE ON THE LIFT AT 150 COLLINS STREET

GPT understands the inconvenience the fault with the carpark lifts caused to the people attending Church especially on Sundays when the lifts were faulty a few weeks ago.

Both faults were completely separate and it was simply bad timing that both the faults happened very close to each other.

GPT wanted to reassure us that they service the lifts monthly which is the Industry standard and have a comprehensive Service Agreement with the lift provider which means that it's in their best interest to return the lifts back into operation as soon as possible before penalties kick in.

If the lift breaks down, we will be given access to the goods lift. This lift stops at the mezzanine, the ground floor, and the carpark loading dock. Access to the goods lift will be clearly signed for you.

Please note that this lift does not go down to the second level of the carpark. This means that - if the normal lift is out of order - you will have to walk from the car park loading dock to your car. If you require wheelchair assistance, please speak to one of our staff members for assistance.

Hopefully this will not be need and we thank GPT for their consideration in offering this other entry way for us.

SCOTS' PRAYER NOTES

June Prayer for Scots

This month's prayer is based on Psalm 145

Verses 1-3

I will exalt you, my God the King....every day I will praise you....Great is the Lord and worthy of praise:

- Our heavenly Father as a church family we praise you for making us and sustaining us.
- Lord you have saved your people and continue to care for us so we take time now to praise you and remember your greatness above all things and all people.

Verses 4-7

One generation will commend your works to another....the glorious splendour of your majesty....your awesome works....your abundant goodness....we sing of your righteousness and meditate on your works.

- Father we thank you for your words being passed down from generation to generation.
- We thank you for the words of Jonah and Isaiah reminding us of your consistent input into the lives of your people and now into our own lives.
- Thank you for the reminder of the warnings you gave to Israel and the reminders of your holiness and righteousness.
- We're sorry for when we haven't lived as you want us to.
- Help us meditate afresh on your word and your character.
- Helps us not just to sing of your righteousness but by your Spirit enable us to live to please you.
- Helps us in our words and actions commend your works and words of salvation to those we live amongst.
- Help our church at Scots to be a community of people who display your goodness and deeds.

Verse 8-9

The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger, rich in love, he is good to all and has compassion on all he has made.

- Father thanks for your example of grace and compassion especially shown in Jesus Christ.
- Help us to be filled with the same love and goodness pouring out of us for all people.
- Help us all to keep being the salt of the earth to our friends and family and to those in need.
- Help our Mission Partners to be kind and compassionate to the people they work amongst.
- Please help Adam and Helane Ramsay to have true compassion for the Japanese people in Chiba. As they focus on educating and teaching leaders of children help them to demonstrate your love, forgiveness and kindness, Help the good news of Jesus go out to all areas of Japan through the lesson material they write.
- Please show your kindness and generosity to Colin and Alison Morrow as Alison has treatment for cancer, thanks that in the midst of the treatment they have had encouraging conversations with farmers and church people about Christ's love for them.

- We pray that all we do at Scots would be seeking to further your kingdom.
- We pray all of our church community would keep their faith and trust in you and your promise of eternity.
- We pray all of our leaders, managers, staff, musicians would encourage us and work towards your name being proclaimed and taught to future generations and that Scots would use all its resources to further your kingdom throughout the generations.

Verses 14-16

The Lord is faithful..loving...upholds those who fall...lifts those who are bowed down. You will give them their food... satisfy their desires.

- Father thanks for your faithfulness to us even when we fall.
- Please forgive us when we sin.
- Please keep lifting us up to have our faces towards you and our hope in you. please help us be people of forgiveness as you have forgiven us.
- Please lift those who are bowed down.
- Father we live in a generation of anxiety, fear, loneliness and depression. Help us to find our strength and comfort in you. Lord just as you've fed the hungry and downcast in the past, please feed us and enable us to care for others as needed.
- We pray especially for those who have faithfully served our church and now are in need of our support.
- We pray for Yvonne Sullivan, Rae Anstee and John Ballantyne.
- We pray for those grieving the loss of lifetime partners and loved ones for Dennis and Andew Conradi and Hans and Litha Heshusius.
- We pray for those going through health challenges particularly Mervat Hanna we ask you would care for her Nader and their family and bring healing and strength to them.

Verses 17-21

The Lord is righteous, loving...near to those who call on him in truth...he hears the cry of those who fear him and saves them, the Lord watches over all. Let every creature praise his Holy name for ever and ever.
